MCAP, civilians be warned

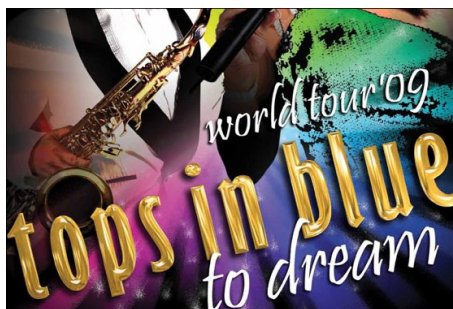
